



Amsterdam, Artist in Residency Studio Rian de Jong, more information:

The studio and apartment are offered for free, but the artist has to take care him/herself of travel expenses, daily maintenance, and a third-party insurance.

The studio is well equipped and has an apartment, fit for two people.

The studio can not be used for heavy or dirty work (no gypsum, dust and dirt, no heavy metalworking). Further restrictions: no pets, no smoking!

In case of complaints from neighbours or the administrator, and if the studio and apartment are not used properly, the foundation is authorized to immediately finish the stay.

In return the Françoise van den Bosch Foundation asks the resident to organise a one day weekend meeting in the studio at the end of the working period, open for the board members, friends and invitee's, to sum up the results of the residency. Further a short report, either in the form of a blog on the foundation's website or as a more static report also to be published on our website would be most welcome.
